## Big Idea of the Week

The imperfect Church perserveres.

- 4. How were the Apostles delivered? What were their specific instructions? How'd they persevere?

5. Read Acts 5:27-33 What specifically were they charged with? What did Peter say that enraged them? How/Why does *this name* still illicit extreme reactions today?

6. Read Acts 5:34-42 What's your take on Gamaliel and his warning/advice?

#### Application

7. Read Acts 6:1-7 What led to the change in structure of the Church? Was this beneficial? Why, then & now?

8. What do you think led to a great many of the priests become obedient to the faith?

9. What led to the *multiplication of the disciples*?
